The purpose of the conference is to bring together CESifo and CRC members to present and discuss their ongoing research, and to stimulate interaction and co-operation between them. All CESifo research network members and all CRC members are invited to submit their papers, which may deal with any topic within the broad domain of behavioral and experimental economics and application to other fields.

All papers presented at the conference will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series.

DISTINGUISHED CESIFO AFFILIATE AWARD

All CESifo Research Fellows are invited to submit nominations for the Distinguished CESifo Affiliate Award, (co-sponsored by the CRC for the Behavioral Economics Area conference), given to the candidate presenting the best paper at the conference. Nominees for this award, aimed at encouraging talented young scholars, must be no more than five years after having completed their Ph.D. (The same limit applies to co-authors in the case of papers with multiple authors). It is not mandatory for candidates to be from the CESifo research network or the CRC. The criteria for the award are scientific originality, policy relevance, and quality of exposition. The winning paper will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series and the prize winner will receive a €3,000 prize. To nominate a candidate, a CESifo Research Fellow must submit the nominee's paper to Klaus Schmidt and Ernst Fehr along with a brief letter explaining the motivation for the nomination. The deadline for nominations is **15 July, 2020**.
