

2013 CESifo Area Conference on Employment and Social Protection



Call for Papers

On **10–11 Mai 2013**, CESifo will organise the annual CESifo Area Conference on Employment and Social Protection in Munich for all members of the CESifo Research Network with an interest in this research area.

The purpose of the workshop is to bring together CESifo members to present and discuss their ongoing research, and to stimulate interaction and co-operation between them. All CESifo Research Network members are invited to submit their papers, which may deal with any topic within the domains of employment and social protection. Both domains are to be broadly defined, the former including, in particular, issues of the organisation of labour. The latter domain, in turn, includes not only governmental institutions of the welfare state, like social insurance, but also other non-governmental institutions of the welfare society, such as the family, or charities and informal networks, social norms and altruistic behaviour.

The keynote lecture will be delivered by Richard Cornes (Australian National University)

The **deadline for submission** of complete papers, or 2-3 page abstracts, is **1 February 2013**. Preference will be given to complete papers.

Please note that the **same paper** is allowed to be submitted to **only one** of the CESifo area conferences. Authors of submitted papers will be notified no later than 15 February 2013 as to whether their paper has been accepted for the workshop. Papers which are more related to the topic of other area conferences may be re-directed to the respective area coordinator.

CESifo will provide accommodation, and reimburse economy travel costs for CESifo Research Fellows/Affiliates with accepted papers. All papers presented at the conference will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series.

Distinguished CESifo Affiliate - Call for Nominations

With the purpose of encouraging talented young scholars, CESifo has instituted the *Distinguished CESifo Affiliate* prize, to be awarded to the best paper presented by a young author at the CESifo Area Conference on Employment and Social Protection.

All CESifo Research Fellows are welcome to nominate candidates for the award (please note that it is not mandatory for candidates to be from the research network).

The following formal requirements should be fulfilled for nominees:

- Nominees should be close to completion of their Ph.D, or have completed their Ph.D. not more than three years ago.
- Nominees are not older than 35.
- If the paper for which a person is nominated is co-authored, then the co-authors also need to be not older than 35.

The criteria for the award are scientific originality, policy relevance and quality of exposition. The winning paper will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series and the prize winner will receive €3000.

To nominate a candidate, a CESifo Research Fellow must submit a paper that is authored or coauthored by the nominee, along with the nominee's CV and a short letter that confirms that the above listed requirements for the nominee and possible co-authors of the nominated paper are fulfilled. Also, the letter should give a short explanation for the nomination
