CESifo and the Department of International and European Economic Studies (DIEES) of the Athens University of Economics and Business (AUEB) invite the submission of papers or extended abstracts (300-500 words) on the question of

## "Current Account Adjustments"

for the CESifo-Delphi Conference 2015, which will take place in Athens, May 15-16, 2015.

Relevant issues and factors for current account adjustment may include:

- The exchange rate regime (external versus internal devaluations)
- The modality of fiscal consolidations (tax versus spending adjustments)
- Firm heterogeneity and export performance
- Labour market reforms
- Financial constraints
- Global value chains

Both theoretical and empirical work is welcome. The deadline for the submission of papers is **February 27, 2015.** 

A decision **on accepted papers for presentation** at the conference will be announced by **March 27, 2015**. Authors of accepted papers will be invited to give presentations at the conference in Athens. All papers presented at the conference will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series. It is expected that selected papers from the conference will be published as a special issue of **CESifo Economic Studies**.

There will be external refereeing of papers after both stages. The organizers will provide accommodation, and reimburse economy travel costs for those with accepted papers. Persons without accepted papers are also welcome to attend, but are expected to provide their own funding for travel and accommodation.
