Submissions to the area conference may deal with any topic in Public Economics, and preference will be given to complete papers. Please note that the same paper is allowed to be submitted to only one of the CESifo Area Conferences. Papers which are more related to the topic of other Area Conferences may be re-directed to the respective Area Director.

In keeping with the tradition of previous years, all participants at the conference are also cordially invited to attend the **Richard Musgrave Lecture** which will take place at 6pm on the first day of the conference. The 2023 **Richard Musgrave Lecture** will be delivered by **Rosanne Altshuler (Rutgers University)**.

#### DISTINGUISHED CESIFO AFFILIATE AWARD

All CESifo Research Fellows are invited to submit nominations for the Distinguished CESifo Affiliate Award, given to the candidate presenting the best paper at the conference. Nominees for this award, aimed at encouraging talented young scholars, must be no more than five years after having completed their Ph.D. (the same limit applies to all co-authors in the case of a paper with multiple authors). It is not mandatory for candidates to be from the CESifo Research Network. The criteria for the award are scientific originality, policy relevance, and quality of exposition. The winning paper will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series, and the prize winner will receive a €2,000 prize.

To nominate a candidate, a CESifo Research Fellow must submit the nominee's paper to Claus Thustrup Kreiner along with a brief description explaining the motivation for the nomination. The deadline for nominations is 9 **January 2023**.
