Many societal challenges require the use of economic instruments to change the behavior of people and companies. Economists often have a clear idea of which instruments are most efficient and how the results of an economic policy can be evaluated ex post. The much harder part is to convince policy makers and the general public to actually use these instruments. The workshop will discuss papers that explore the public understanding of how certain economic policy instruments work, what determines their popularity, and how to make good economic policies politically acceptable.
