## DISTINGUISHED CESifo AFFILIATE AWARD

Accepted candidates will be invited to attend and present their paper. Candidates must be no more than five years after completing their PhD (same applies to any co-authors). The winning paper will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series, and the prize winner will receive a  $\leq 2,000$  prize.

All CESifo Research Fellows are welcome to nominate candidates by submitting the nominee's paper to Eric Hanushek and Ludger Woessmann along with a CV and a brief note explaining the motivation for the nomination. The deadline for nominations is **2 June 2024**.
